School Behaviour Policy for Students

The aim of our School Behaviour Policy is to create a safe, respectful, and conducive learning environment for all students. Behaviour Protocol for Students

- 1. Respect and Kindness:** Treat all members of the school community, including peers, teachers, and staff, with respect and kindness. Bullying, harassment, or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- 2. Responsibility:** Take responsibility for your actions and their consequences. This includes being accountable for your behaviour in and out of the classroom.
- 3. Cooperation:** Work cooperatively with teachers and classmates. Follow instructions promptly and participate actively in class activities.
- 4. Safety:** Prioritize the safety of yourself and others. This includes following school rules, using equipment properly, and reporting any unsafe conditions or behaviours to a staff member.
- 5. Integrity:** Uphold academic integrity by completing your own work honestly and avoiding cheating or plagiarism.
- 6. Communication:** Use appropriate language and tone when communicating with others. Refrain from using offensive or inappropriate language.
- 7. Conflict Resolution:** Address conflicts in a constructive manner. Seek help from school counsellor, teacher or staff member if you are unable to resolve a disagreement.

8. Attendance and Punctuality: Attend school regularly and arrive on time for classes. Notify the school of any absences in a timely manner.

Consequences for Non-Compliance with Behaviour Policy

If a student is found guilty of violating the policy, strict actions will be taken. These actions may include suspension or even expulsion from the school.
